Dear International Bridge Building Contest Participant,

Congratulations on qualifying for the 2022 International Bridge Building Contest. This year's event will be held at North Pocono High School, 97 Bochicchio Blvd, Covington Township, PA 18444, on May 7, 2022. There is a tentative event planned for Friday late afternoon/evening. Please try to make arrangement that allow you to attend.

Along with this letter, you will find the three documents listed below along with your official bridge wood kit.

1. The 2022 International Bridge Building Contest Specifications¹. These specifications are identical to those found on our website unless there have been changes made after the date of this letter. The requirements listed in the specifications must be met to qualify for the competition. If you intend to mail your bridge in, please be sure to follow the specifications carefully as modifications will not be permitted by anyone other than the participant. Your bridge may be sent to the address shown above. Be sure to package your bridge appropriately to avoid damage in transit.
2. The registration form for the contest. Please complete this form as soon as possible, but no later than April 29, 2022. Submission of the scanned form via email is preferred but you may also send the completed form to the address above.
3. Airport/hotel suggestions, and area Map.
4. The Official Bridge Wood Kit. The kit is comprised of 25, 24-inch sticks of 3/32 inch basswood. This is the wood that must be used to build your bridge.

As we complete preparations for the contest, I will be forwarding information about the Friday event via email. Please watch for these emails.

NOTE: Our event planned for Friday evening is still tentative at this time. We are planning to have a private group tour of the Steamtown National Historic Site in downtown Scranton, PA immediately followed by a pizza party. Transportation to the event is expected to be on your own. More to follow once the arrangements are confirmed.
